Senior Portraits

You are responsible for scheduling your portrait date...

- Over summer break portrait sessions will be held at Newtown High School. Schedule your appointment at https://www.photographybyroman.net/
- All portrait sessions at NHS:
- June 17, 18, 19 Auditorium
- July 16, 17, 18 and 29, 30, 31 Auditorium
- August 26, Auditorium
- September 10, 11, 12 Cafetorium Stage
- Your proofs will be available online approximately two weeks after your portrait session. You will need to select your yearbook pose on the website

Formal Senior Portraits

Dress Requirements for Yearbook Pose

- Option 1: A solid button down collared shirt with tie (plain jacket optional)
- Option 2: A solid colored long sleeve semi formal/formal top. Black is suggested

The picture background is **blue**.

- Baby Pictures: Send in pictures now!
- Email a digital picture as an *attachment* to yearbook@newtown.k12.ct.us

SUPER IMPORTANT:

- Include your last name, first name in the subject followed by the word "BARY"
- Save your image with the same info
 - Example file name: Violette Kristin Baby
- Your FILE NAME MUST have your last and first name in that order
- Picture must be HIGH RESOLUTION (not a picture of

Senior Quotes

- → Submit through Naviance Survey
- → Limit of 133 characters
- → Send 2 quote options, in case your first quote is rejected
- → Your quote <u>must</u> be in the original form
- → Attach with a link to a <u>credible source</u>
- → If both of your quotes are rejected by administration, you will NOT be notified and you will NOT have a quote in the book
- → Quote AND its context must be appropriate! (in other words do not select the one clean line from an inappropriate song)
- → We would like to receive your baby picture and senior quote before the start of the school year

Senior Quote Guidelines

Your quote must follow these guidelines set by **Administration:**

- 1. Verifiable and appropriate quotes from famous people, artists, authors or public figures (ex: Brainy quote).
- 2. Family members are acceptable (other than self) as long as these are appropriate.
- 3. Quotes from social media need to come from a verified account and be appropriate as well. Even if quotes come from famous people or artists, the appropriateness of the quote is still priority.
- 4. Only full-length quotes and statements are acceptable. Extracting a piece of a quote (out of context) will not be accepted.
- 5. If the connotation of the quote is deemed unacceptable, you will be asked to submit another quote.
- 6. Yearbook advisers and administration reserve the right to deny a quote from being included in the book. Failure to submit a quote by the deadline will result in no quote in the yearbook.

MEMES AND INSPIRATIONAL PICTURES ARE NOT ACCEPTED

Requirements to be in Sr. Section

You MUST submit at least 2 of the following items (on time) in order for your picture to be in alpha order in the formal section of the yearbook

- 1. FORMAL SENIOR PORTRAIT
- 2. BABY PICTURE
- 3. ACCEPTED SENIOR QUOTE

Senior Siblings

- If you have a sibling that is going to be attending NHS as of the fall you can send in a photo to be considered for use.
- Send to: yearbook@newtown.k12.ct.us
- Include both of your names and the subject "Senior Siblings" in the subject line.
- Make sure there are no glares and it is not blurry, or we will ask you to send in another one.
- Only current NHS students are allowed to be printed in the yearbook.

Remember When

- Similarly to senior siblings and baby pictures, we also give seniors the opportunity to send in throwback pictures.
- If you have any pictures you would like to send in to have in the book, email them to our <u>yearbook email</u> with "Remember when" as the subject.
- Photos must be appropriate for school.
- Only NHS students can be in the pictures.
